### RECIPE OF THE MONTH

#### S'MORES BARS

- 8 cups mini marshmallows, divided
  - ¼ cup butter
  - ¼ tsp. salt
  - 1 ¾ cups milk chocolate chips, divided
  - 8 whole graham crackers, broken into ½" pieces
- 1) Line a 8" or 9" square baking pan with foil or parchment paper, leaving an overhang on two sides. Spray with cooking spray.
  - 2) Heat six cups marshmallows, butter, and salt in a large saucepan over medium heat for 5 or 8 minutes until smooth stirring frequently. Remove from the heat.
  - 3) Add 1 cup chocolate chips and stir the mixture until smooth.
  - 4) Stir in the graham crackers and remaining marshmallows and chocolate chips.
  - 5) Spread into the prepared pan with a spatula that has been sprayed with cooking spray. Press down lightly. Let cool until set.
  - 6) Remove from the pan using the overhanging foil or parchment paper. Peel it off before cutting into squares.
- YIELD: 24 bars
